- Preventive Maintenance
- Scheduled Maintenance
- Planned Maintenance





PM Objectives

- Safe, effective, reliable medical equipment
- Extension of useful lifetime
- Compliance with AHJ (Authority Having Jurisdiction)





PM Terminology

- PM Activities: What we do.
- PM Frequency: When we do it.
- PM Procedure: Set of PM Activities + PM Frequency





Types of PM Activities

Device Restoration

- Genuine preventive maintenance
- Intended to reduce the likelihood of failure

Safety Verification

- Inspect for safe & effective function
- Identify latent failures not obvious to user
- Requires specialized knowledge or equipment





PM Performance Monitoring





PM Completion =

#Completed on Schedule

#Scheduled – #Unavailable





Mean Time Between Failures: MTBF

(# devices) x (# years analyzed)
(# failures of all types)





PM-related Failures

- Failures that could have been prevented by better PM
 - Example: Early failure of infusion pump battery
- Hidden failures that could have been discovered by better PM
 - Example: Low defibrillator output





Mean Time Between PM-Related Failures: MTBFPM

(# devices)(# years analyzed)

(# preventable failures) + (# discoverable failures)
